START

SUGAR

(In a loud whisper)

Daphne --

(Music fades out)

(Jerry sits bolt upright and hits his head against the top of the berth)

Ow! Sugar! -- What are you -- ?

SUGAR

I wanted to thank you for covering up for me. You're a real pal.

JERRY

It was nothing -- I just think us girls should stick together.

SUGAR

Listen -- if there's ever anything I can do for you --

Oh, I can think of a million things --

SUE

(Appearing)

Bienstock -- !

(SUGAR hops up into the berth)

-- and that's one of them!

SUGAR

Shh! Sweet Sue. I don't want her to know we're in chaoots!

JERRY

We won't tell anybody -- not even Josephine.

SUGAR

I'd better stay here till she goes back to sleep.

Listen, you stay as long as you like!

SUGAR

I'm not crowding you, am I?

JERRY

Noooo! It's nice and cozy this way.

SUGAR

Say, are you all right? You're trembling all over!

JERRY

That's ridiculous.

SUGAR

And your head is hot.

JERRY

That's ridiculous.

SUGAR

And you've got cold feet.

JERRY

(A wan smile)

Isn't that ridiculous?

SUGAR

Look, maybe you're coming down with something.

JERRY

I certainly hope so.

SUGAR

The best thing is a shot of whiskey. I've still got some hidden away in my berth.

(SHE leans across him, reaching into her own berth next door)

JERRY

I'm a girl, I'm a girl, I'm a girl --

(Now SUGAR returns, carrying a hot water bottle and some paper cups)

SUGAR

Here, you pour. I brought some cups, too.

JERRY

(Pouring)

You think of everything! You know, this just might turn out to be a surprise party.

SUGAR

Oh, really? What's the surprise?

JERRY

(Coyly)
Uh-uh -- not yet!

SUGAR

When?

JERRY

We better have a drink first.

SUGAR

Good idea. This'll put hair on your chest.

JERRY

No fair guessing!

(Music starts)

SUGAR

You know, Daphne, I've got this very highly developed intuition and the moment we first met I knew we were very much alike.

SUGAR SIDE TWO START

SUGAR (Cont'd)

(Spotting a stuffed marlin on

the wall)

What a beautiful fish!

JOE

Yes. I caught him off Cape Hatteras.

SUGAR

What is it?

JOE

Oh -- a member of the herring family.

SUGAF

(Spotting a silver cup)

What's this trophy for?

(During this HE has opened the champagne and filled two glasses)

JOE

Uh -- water polo.

SUGAR

Water polo -- isn't that terribly dangerous?

JOE

I'll say! I had two ponies drown under me.

(Toasting her)

Down the hatch -- as we say at sea.

SUGAR

Bon voyage.

JOE

Why don't we sit down?

SUGAR

Uh -- say, you don't sail this thing all by yourself, do you?

JOE

Goodness no!

SUGAR

Then where is everybody?

JOE

It's the crew's night off. Thursday.

SUGAR

You mean we're alone on the boat?

JOE

Completely.

SUGAR

Hey -- I've never been completely alone with a man before -- not in the middle of the ocean --

JOE

Oh, it's perfectly safe. We're well-anchored -- the ship's in shipshape shape -- and the Coast Guard promised to call me if there are any icebergs. So there's nothing to worry about.

SUGAR
